
#### Let's get our bodies into space!


#### Challenge time: turn your circle inside out!

Use your body to transform into the following:








# Vocabulary Definitions

ASTRONAUT	• A person who is trained to travel in a spacecraft.
COMET	• An icy rock that lets off gas and dust, which may form tails when it is flying close to a sun.
CONSTELLATION	A group of stars in the sky. They're often named after an animal, object, or person.
COSMOS	• The universe seen as an orderly, harmonious whole.
EARTH	• The fifth largest planet in the Solar System and third from the Sun.
GALAXY	A collection of thousands to billions of stars held together by gravity. The galaxy we live ir is called the Milky Way.
IMAGINE	• To form in the mind a thought, picture, or image.
MAGIC	• When the impossible is made possible.
MOON	• A natural satellite which orbits the Earth. Other planets may have one or multiple moons.
MUSIC	• Sound and rhythm made with voices or instruments that can be listened to and enjoyed.
MYSTERY	• A matter that is secret or that cannot be known or explained.
ORBIT	• The curved path a planet, satellite, or spacecraft moves as it circles around another object.
PLANET	• A large body in outer space that circles around the sun or another star.
SPACE	Everything outside of Earth's atmosphere where planets, stars and cosmic wonders exist.
STAR	A ball of shining gas held together by its own gravity.
WONDER	• To be curious about or to question something unknown.
